

Reach the Broken Relentlessly

Have you ever been to a large event with a huge crowd of people, and suddenly felt overwhelmed with the thought that most of these people do not have a personal relationship with Jesus? With so many people who need Jesus, how can I make a difference?

So he {Jesus} told them this parable; "What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he has lost one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the open country, and go after the one that is lost, until he finds it? And when he has found lays it on his shoulders. he rejoicing. And when he comes home, he calls together his friends neighbors, saying to them, "Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep that was lost." Just so, I tell you, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance. (Luke 15:1-7)

Jesus tells how to make us а difference. Find the one. Do not become overwhelmed by the enormity of all of the lost, focus on one. Each of us has one person that we have a close relationship with who needs Jesus. A family member, a neighbor, a co-worker. The shepherd left all of the sheep to go tend to the one. Notice it was the shepherd who took the initiative and deliberately went out to find the lost sheep. Identify your "lost sheep". Who is the one God wants you to bring the good news of Jesus?

Next, the shepherd looked until he found the sheep. Be persistent with your one. Look for opportunities to show the love of Jesus to your lost sheep. God will open the doors, but we need to be paying attention and ready to act. Simple acts of kindness. Encouraging notes. Kind words. Helping hands. Your one is lost, you have the only answer. Lead them to the Savior.

Then, the shepherd found the lost sheep. He rejoiced! He called his friends together to celebrate with him. There was even rejoicing in heaven. So many Christians are somber and serious. We should be the most joyful people on the planet. We know this earth is not the end, but just the beginning of something truly glorious. There is rejoicing and celebrating every time a person comes to know Christ as personal Savior. When your one comes to know Christ, share that good news with others, especially your church family. God has answered your prayers. A lost sheep has been found.

God sees us as individuals. He did not send us to bring the gospel to the masses. He calls us to bring the gospel to one person at a time. Who is your one?
