A Song With a Message?

According to folklore, the long "The 12 Days of Christmas" was written to help young believers learn about their faith. Although no evidence proves that claim, some say the popular carol contains these codes:

- •The 10 lords a-leaping are the Ten Commandments.
- •The 11 pipers piping stand for the 11 faithful disciples.
- •The 12 drummers drumming symbolize the 12 statements of belief in the Apostles' Creed.
